16. The said location where the applicant proposes to sell alcoholic liquors at retail pursuant temporary license is not within 100 feet of any church, school, hospital, home for aged or indigent persons, or for veterans, their wives or children, or any military or naval station.

17. Applicant has been a resident of Tazewell County, Illinois, for at least ninety days and a registered voter properly registered in the county's permanent registration file.

Applicant agrees and understands that the license, if granted, is for one location only and cannot be moved to another separate location, that it includes, incorporates and is to be interpreted by the laws of the State of Illinois, the resolutions of the county board of Tazewell County, the lease, this application, and the circumstances surrounding the issuance of the license, and other factors, and that any license issued by the liquor control commissioner contrary to the laws of the State of Illinois or the resolutions of the county board of Tazewell County is void whether or not signed and delivered.

Section 135 of the Illinois Dram Shop Act makes any person selling or giving alcoholic liquor as well as persons owning, renting, leasing or permitting the occupation of any building or premises with knowledge that alcoholic liquors are sold therein, liable to every person injured in person or property by any person intoxicated by such selling or giving of alcohol.
