Thank you for your interest in serving as an Election Judge.

As an Election Judge, you are expected to be at the polls at 5:00 a.m. and remain there until after the polls close at 7:00 p.m., including the time it takes to complete precinct paperwork. Two judges then transport the materials to the ESDA (Tremont) building. The pay for judges is \$220.00. The two judges transporting election materials and paperwork back to the ESDA (Tremont) building receive an additional \$5, plus mileage.

Election judges are required to work representing either the Republican or Democrat Party. Please be aware that when working as a judge during a Primary election you must vote the party ballot you are serving or not vote. During the General election you may vote for whichever party candidate you wish. We also require each judge to attend one of our training classes.
