This agreement allows us to partake in an opportunity for federal funding with local matching. He added that the

Broadway Rd. project is an example of an awarded program. The committee had an in-depth conversation about how Tri-County Regional Planning Commission functions and selects projects. A list showing each entity's contribution was shared with the committee. Tazewell County's share for Tri-County's FY2025

Agreement, (Tazewell County's FY2024 budget), is \$42,450.95.

Mr. Parr reminded the committed that all bids had to be rejected last month due to a couple different factors. A new engineering estimate was completed to account for current prices and inflation. The bid still came in higher than the estimate, but Mr. Parr, Mr. Augspurger, and the representative from GIVSCO all explained that times are uncertain and prices are continuing to rise. Unfortunately, the project will not get any cheaper by waiting. Mr. Augspurger explained that there are funds in both County Motor Fuel and County Highway to cover the overages. However, some of those funds may have to come from Contingency within County Highway rather than other line items.

OLD BUSINESS: DECO Grant

Mr. Parr informed the committee that Mr. Augspurger has secured the permit and application for the \$5,000,000 grant through DCEO (Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity) for use on pavement. The current step is awaiting signatures. The committee thanked Mr. Augspurger for his work on acquiring the grant.

PROJECT UPDATES:

Design/Construction Mr. Parr gave a brief update of all of the current projects.

OTHER BUSINESS: In-Place, IDOT – BLR Form for Renovation

Mr. Parr advised the committee that an In-Place meeting would be necessary to pass an IDOT form that appropriates more Motor Fuel Tax for the renovation project overages. He explained that this is standard practice for all Motor Fuel expenditures. This step was already completed for the funds we estimated, but the additional funds needed will have to be appropriated by IDOT as well.
