PUBLIC COMMENTS:	None
MINUTES:	MOTION BY HARRIS, SECOND BY HALL to approve the minutes of the September 17, 2024, meeting. MOTION CARRIED on voice vote.
OLD BUSINESS: Maintenance Foreman Stipend	Chairman Menold reminded the committee of the discussion last month about the stipend for Maintenance Foreman Scott Williams. Unfortunately, Mr. Parr and Mr. Williams were unable to attend the meeting in September so this discussion was tabled until both were able to be present to discuss matters in more detail. Chairman Menold passed about some information from Mr. Williams regarding his miles travel, the cost of fuel, and what it is costing him to operate his truck. He explained the figures and verbalized that since the stipend is taxed, the amount that he is actually receiving is not covering his cost to drive his own vehicle for work purposes by several hundred dollars. He explained that while there are advantages to him personally to be able to drive his personal vehicle for work, it is costing him far too much out of his own pocket. The committee's general consensus, along with Mr. Parr's, was that it is very beneficial to Tazewell County to have Mr. Williams readily available by using his own vehicle. It's advantageous during winter, emergencies, and even throughout the construction season. It was also noted that this all began because the crew was using the very expensive bucket truck as a regular maintenance vehicle. Due to the economy, no vehicles were available to purchase, and Mr. Williams suggested adding the County-owned Maintenance Foreman truck to the regular fleet and driving his own. The issue was voted on back in November 2022 with plans to revisit. The committee also noted that the issue had not been revisited since that time. Mr. Williams also provided information to show what the cost of purchasing a new vehicle from the statewide purchasing contract and compared this to the cost of increasing his stipend. It was still deemed cost effective to allow Mr. Williams to drive his personal vehicle when all other vehicle ownership factors were considered. It was as confirmed that no language of the previously approved resolution had changed, only the dollar amount from \$1,500 to \$2,000 per month.

County Engineer Salary	In addition to the Maintenance Foreman Stipend being tabled, the County Engineer Salary was also briefly discussed last month with the intent to discuss again in October. Chairman Menold thanked everyone for their evaluations and gave a copy to anyone still needing one.

	He also explained that IDOT has still not released their minimum salary requirements to take part in the County Engineer Salary Program. That being said, Tazewell County has always been above that number, and there is no concern with not qualifying.

	Chairman Menold moved the Committee out of Executive Session at 2:00 P.M.
	MOTION BY HALL, SECOND BY NELMS to recommend a 4% increase of the County Engineer's salary for January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. MOTION CARRIED on a voice vote.
	The committee confirmed a 4% raise for Mr. Dan Parr for Calendar Year 2025.
RESOLUTION: T-24-32	MOTION BY HALL, SECOND BY NELMS to recommend a 4% increase of the County Engineer's salary for January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. MOTION CARRIED on a voice vote.
NEW BUSINESS: Parkway Dr. Resurfacing	Mr. Parr stated an application was submitted through Tri-County Regional Planning Commission, and we were fortunate enough to receive Federal Funds to resurface the County's portion of Parkway Dr. He explained that it will be a joint funding agreement with IDOT. He stated the project will cost approximately \$300,000, and Tazewell County's share will be \$60,000 from our Matching Tax Funds. Mr. Parr stated that this is in the budget for FY25 and has also been in the five-year capital plan in hopes that it would proceed.
RESOLUTION: T-24-33	MOTION BY HALL, SECOND BY NELMS to recommend to the County Board approval of the joint funding agreement with IDOT for Parkway Dr. resurfacing. MOTION CARRIED on a voice vote
PROJECT UPDATES:	
Design/Construction	Mr. Parr gave a brief update on all of the projects with recent changes.
	He stated most of the resurfacing work is complete. Mr. Harris complimented the work on Dee Mack and stated the interruption during school and harvest was minimal and stated that it looks great and rides nicely. Ms. Proehl echoed the same sentiment for the work on Manito Rd.
	The shop renovations are proceeding but there have been several items that have come up during the process that have needed addressed, added, or changed. He stated it comes with the territory of the work. He explained that the most recent issue has been a rather large issue. If the plan in the design had been followed, it could have caused a much larger cost down the road, and possibly worse, as in structural issues.

Mr. Williams	Mr. Williams informed the committee of recent health issues. He explained that he will be going through several months of treatments, and while his availability may be limited at times, the crew will be covered and will maintain their status as usual. The committee members expressed their concerned and thanked Mr. Williams for the update.
Teamsters Negotiation	The committee members inquired about the current status with the Teamsters negotiation. Chairman Menold advised that the final offer from Tazewell County has not yet been offered so negotiations are still underway.
REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS:	
Financial Reports	Ms. Sciortino informed the committee of a bill for Best Buy around \$400 that will show on next month's bills as reimbursement to her. She stated it was for software that was going to be purchased with the Highway's account, but it was unknown that the account was dormant when she arrived in Peoria for the purchase. The software had to be purchased in store, so she covered the cost and submitted a receipt for reimbursement instead of making a second trip to Peoria, due to time and mileage.
