ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH Environmental Health Supervisor Stacy Thompson stated that they have had their first positive West Nile mosquito pool in Pekin. She stated that they also had their first West Nile virus case and death in Tazewell County.

ANIMAL CONTROL Animal Control Director Libby Aeschleman provided an overview of the September and October reports.

Director Aeschleman provided an update on the Feral Cat Trap, Spay/Neuter, and Release Program. She stated that there has been a total of 133 cats trapped and released. She described the process of the program.

HEALTH Administrator Amy Fox stated that November is the month when the Health Department will be moving into the new Broadway building. She stated that they will be moving on the 14th and 15th. She stated that they will start services on November 18th and clinic will begin on November 20th. She stated that the ribbon cutting and open house will be on November 19th at 3:00 p.m.

Administrator Fox stated that they are hoping to get a dentist two days a week and keep a hygiene program running on the days that the dentist is not there while they work toward a full time dentist.

Administrator Fox stated that the people that come to them will be on a variety of insurances. She stated that if their insurance will not pay, they use a sliding scale to help with the costs.

SOLID WASTE Environmental Health Director Melissa Goetze stated that they held their electronic recycling on October 7th and it was a very successful event. She stated that there was no charge to residents.

Director Goetze stated that they are doing their Christmas tree recycling which will be performed by Wilson's Tree Service.

Director Goetze provided a handout entitled "Waste Reduction and Recycling Grant Application 2025" and provided an overview. She stated that Tazewell County is implementing a program called Recycle Coach. She stated that this program is funded by the Illinois EPA and is free for all counties in Illinois. She stated that residents would have their own sign-in and would have access to a recycling calendar, will be able to set reminders, will be able to find drop-off locations, and will be able to see what type of items can be recycled.

Chairman Hall recessed the meeting at 6:11 p.m.
