THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board approve the recommended changes of precinct boundaries.

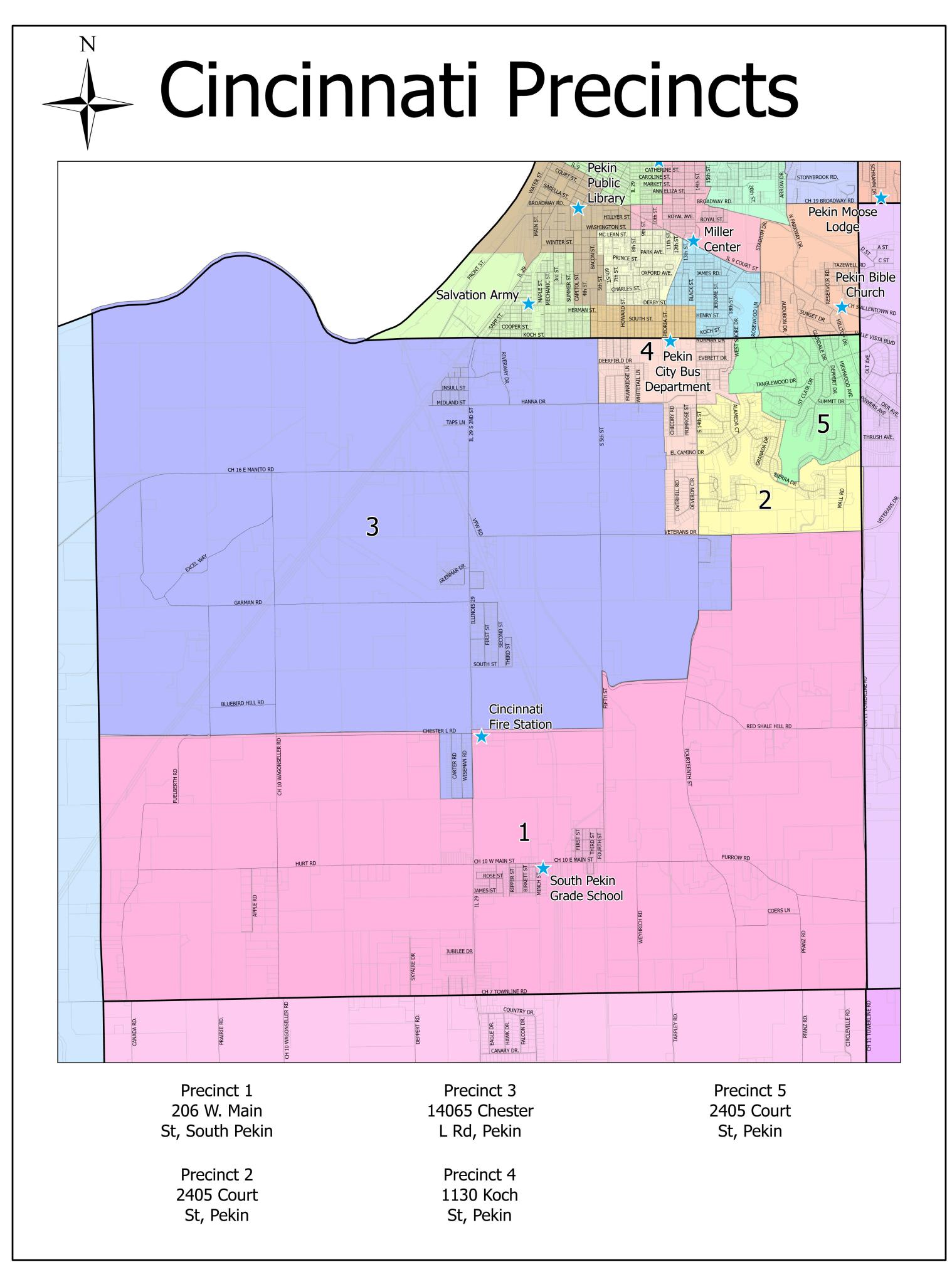
