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The following Special Provision supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted

January 1, 2022, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specification and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction of the above named section, and in case of conflict with any parts, or parts of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

AGGREGATE QUALITY: Coarse aggregate for Granular Embankment Special, Sub-base Granular Material, Aggregate Shoulders, Aggregate Surface and Base Course, and Erosion Control Aggregate shall conform to Article 1004.04 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction."

GRADATION: The gradation shall be CA-6.

QUANTITIES: No definite quantity of gravel or crushed stone aggregate is shown on this proposal. Vendors or producers are hereby notified that the Road District reserves the right to order only such quantities of material as may be required during 2026. (For approximate quantities see Material Quotation sheet.)

SPECIFICATIONS: The gravel or crushed stone aggregate shall conform to the requirements set forth in the Standard Specifications and the following Special Provisions.

INSPECTION AND TESTS: The Road District reserves the right to inspect all materials as to quality and to reject any materials not meeting the specifications. Bidders are respectfully referred to the Standard Specifications mentioned above which gives complete detail for preparation and manufacture of the materials.

DELIVERY: The material shall be delivered only as ordered by the Highway Commissioner or his authorized agent.

QUOTATIONS: The prices per ton shall be for material loaded into Malone Road District trucks and their hired or rented trucks. Bidders shall indicate in the Material Proposal form, price per ton for the material they propose to furnish and location of the pit or quarry from which the trucks are being loaded F.O.B. Quotations from more than one pit or quarry shall be on separate forms.

Quotations submitted shall include all applicable taxes.

Prices quoted shall be effective until December 31, 2026.

DELIVERY SLIPS: The vendor shall furnish delivery slips to the Highway Commissioner for each load of material hauled from the vendor's pit or quarry. Their delivery slips shall show (1) date of delivery; (2) quantity in pounds or tons; (3) name and signature of the Road District employee receiving the load, and one copy of such delivery slip shall be handed to the driver.

INVOICES: Vendors may combine several deliveries on one invoice but all invoices shall list each delivery slip showing slip number, date and the quantity of material.

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AWARD: The right is reserved to reject any or all bids and to make awards in the best interest of the Road District.

DIFFERENCE IN HAUL: In comparing bids for materials where delivery is F.O.B. trucks at plant, the difference in haul will be considered. The cost of hauling, based on a price of \$1.10 per ton mile, will be added to the unit price submitted in order to determine the low bidder. The bidder shall indicate the location of the plant on the Material Proposal. The cost of hauling will be computed from the pit to the 12834 Nichols Road, Green Valley, Illinois 61534, located in Malone Township, as driven by the most appropriate route.
